TEAM REP RESPONSIBILITIES

All Team Reps are responsible for reporting information to their Players and STEEL CITY staff. Your required duties are as follows:

- You are required to be present at all Team Rep meetings that are scheduled. If you are unable to attend please have a representative from your team be there in your place
- All Team Reps are expected to communicate with STEEL CITY HOCKEY staff. With this our first season, it is important we all get to know each other in regards to questions, concerns, and suggestions
- Please treat entire STEEL CITY HOCKEY staff with mutual respect
- Be sure to field ALL Questions, Concerns, and Suggestions from your Players to the STEEL CITY Convenors. It is easier to go through one person, (Player Rep), that way everyone receives the same answer and we all stay on the same page
- You are expected to keep your Team and Players under control during games, in the hallways, and in the dressing rooms
- Please be sure your TEAM ROSTERS are always up to date and ALL changes are reported to the STEEL CITY Convenors. There will be a date given for all teams to have their FINAL ROSTERS handed in
- Due to insurance reasons, non registered players will not be allowed to play. It is the Team Rep's responsibility to ensure no illegal players are on your roster. Teams caught using an illegal player/players will automatically forfeit the game. Please be sure ALL PLAYERS have a helmet sticker.
- On game nights you are responsible for making sure the game sheet is properly filled out with your Teams roster and signatures. The game will not start until the time keeper has the game sheet and ALL players have signed it
- You are responsible for knowing and communicating the LEAGUE RULES for the STEEL CITY MEN'S LEAGUE
